3. PRAYER AND FASTING

THE SOURCE OF STRENGTH, **POWER**, **GROWTH**, AND DISCIPLINE FOR AN **OVERCOMING** CHRISTIAN LIFE.

4. COMMUNITY

WHERE A PERSON RECEIVES **HELP**, SUPPORT, CORRECTION, REBUKE, ENCOURAGEMENT, AND **FELLOWSHIP** NEEDED TO LIVE A SUCCESSFUL CHRISTIAN LIFE, AND THE OPPORTUNITY TO **MINISTER** TO OTHERS.

5. _____ BAPTISM

A SYMBOLIC ACT THAT SIGNIFIES THE **REALITY** OF THE CROSS IN THE LIFE OF THE BELIEVER. IT IS A MEANS OF **IDENTIFYING** WITH CHRIST.

6. SANCTIFICATION

THE **ONGOING**, PROGRESSIVE WORK OF **PURIFYING** AND **PERFECTING** THE BELIEVER.

THE **DIVINELY** ORDAINED TRIALS AND TESTS, WHICH PRODUCE STRENGTH, **CHARACTER**, OBEDIENCE, AND **PERSEVERANCE**.

8. MINISTRY

THE CALL OF GOD TO **SERVICE** THAT IS ACCOMPANIED BY **EMPOWERMENT**, MINISTRY GIFTS, AND THE ABILITY TO GET THE WORK OF GOD **DONE**.

9. _____ BAPTISM

AN EXPERIENCE WHERE **MORE** POWER FOR LIFE AND MINISTRY IS GIVEN. IT **INCLUDES** THE ABILITY TO EXTRA-NATURALLY COMMUNICATE WITH GOD BY MEANS OF EXTRA-NATURAL SPEECH.
